  - High delivery of service










### **Objectives of Citizen Charter**

- Improve service delivery on the lines of Citizens expectations
- Instil professionalism in Panchayat
  functioning
- Promote collaboration of all sections
  of community without any prejudice
- Develop yardsticks for monitoring and evaluation of service delivery






### **Citizen Charter Components**



- Vision and Mission Statement
  - Vision enumerating the ultimate direction in which the Panchayat seeks to move
  - Mission statement detailing the specific objectives which drive the Panchayat in tune with the vision
- Service standards/ Procedures\*
  - Name of the service
  - Details of the service including beneficiaries and eligible persons
  - Time frame & charges to deliver the service
  - Name and contact details of the person in the Panchayat responsible for providing the service
- Grievance Redressal Mechanisms
  - Contact details of the authority to whom citizen need to contact for any complains

\*Panchayats to act as facilitator for services not directly offered through them


## **Preparation of Citizen Charter: Process**





- 1. Lay down the **Vision and Mission** statements with a progressive outlook
- 2. Discuss and ascertain in consultation with officers of the concerned line departments
  - i. Various services provided/ to be provided to the Citizens; Services to cover 29 sectors, aligning actions with localised Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
  - ii. Conditions citizens have to fulfil to avail a service
  - iii. Time limit of each service
- 3. Develop grievance redressal mechanisms
- 4. Decide the **fee leviable** for particular services
- 5. Formalize and adopt the Citizen Charter through Gram Sabha resolution

#### Every Panchayat to prepare a Citizen Charter by 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2021; States to draw a timebound plan of action









- Abstract copy of Ordinary Resident Register (ORR).
- 2. Birth Certificate.
- 3. Death Certificate.
- 4. Issue of MGNREGA Job card.
- 5. Marriage Certificate.
- 6. Trade Licence.
