The GPDP does three essential things:

- It provides a **VISION** of what the people would like their village to look like
- It sets out clear **GOALS** to achieve that vision, and
- Provides an **ACTION PLAN** to reach those goals.

Why GPDP

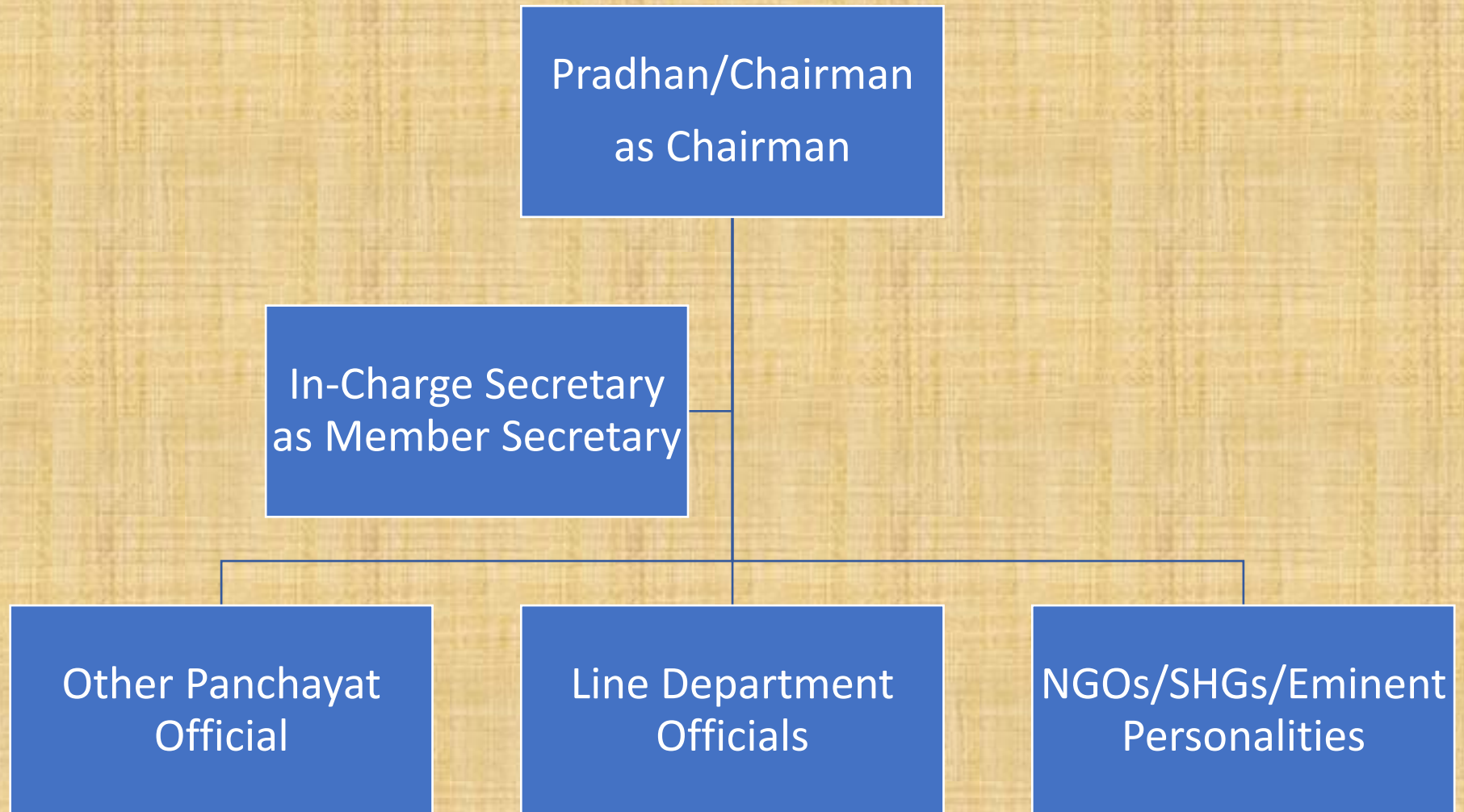
- Article 243-G of the Indian Constitution

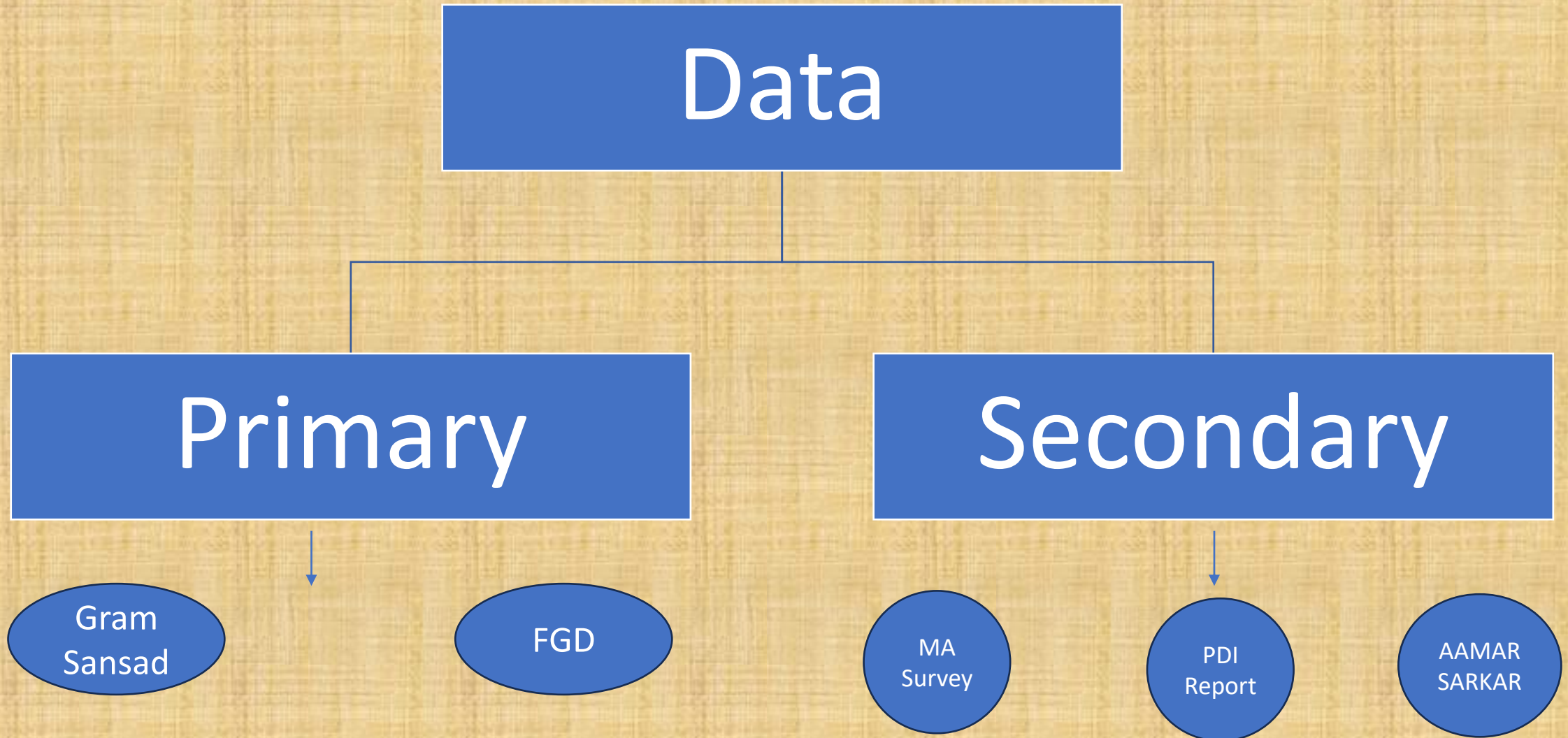



Preparation of Draft Plan

- Draft plan shall be prepared indicating the works identified in each focus area along with cost estimation/fund allocation, timelines for completion of works.

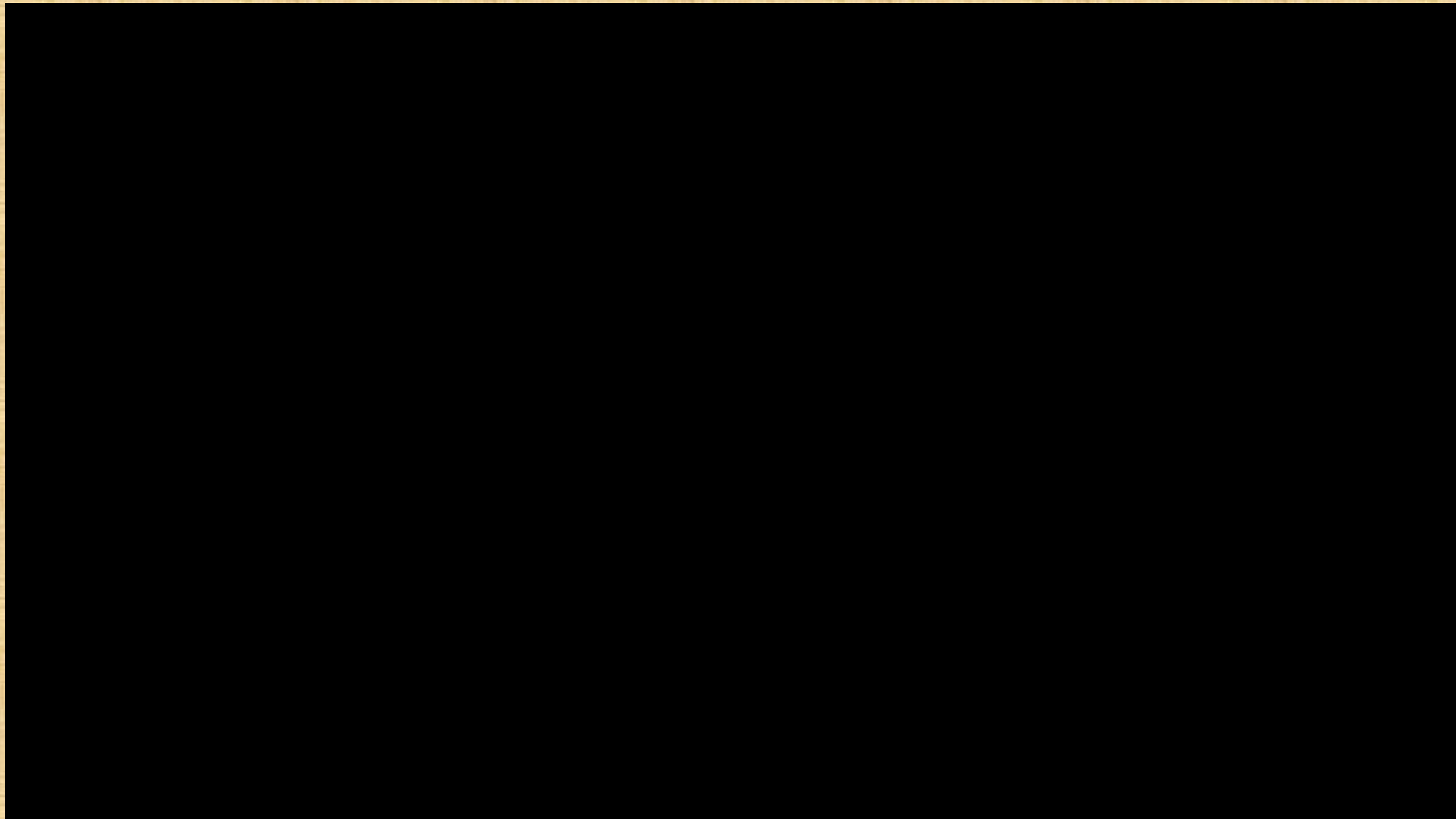

Important Points in GPDP

- SANKALP to be taken (at least one)
- Plan to be made as per LSDG Theme
- At least 25% of activities from the SANKALP Themes
- At least 25% fund allocation from the untied portion among SANKALP Themes
- Inclusion of VPRP activities
- Inclusion of Zero/Low-Cost activities
- Conduct of Mahila and Child Sabha
- Inclusion of activity from the demand raised in Mahila and Child Sabha
- Avoid inclusion of activities by putting budgetary allocations like Rs.5, 100, etc.
