Organize Health Camp with collaboration with Health Sub Centre at GP/VC. The main focus of the Health Camp will be entrusted -

To identify all persons above 40 years suffering from Diabetes (Register No.4).



Monitor the Height & Weight of all the AWC going children once in every four months to detect the Stunted, Wasted & Underweight children (Register No. 5).





Organize a special drive in Anganwadi Centers (AWC) and schools to identify anaemic children and ensure they receive necessary medical care and supplementary nutrition (Register No. 6).





Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers and ensure medical facility & supplementary food for them (Register No. 7)





Ensure monthly health check-ups for all bedridden individuals in the village to monitor and improve their well-being. (Register No. 8)



Nurture the Nutri-Gardens of all AWC and Schools, once in every two months through 'Shramdan' efforts.





Organize awareness programmes on Adolescent Health in schools once in every Six months.

Organize Blood Donation Camp once in a year. The GP/VCs are requested to ensure atleast 10 donors and the concerned Block Development Officers are urged to conduct the Blood Donation Camp with all the GP/VC under his/her jurisdiction inclusively





- Implementation of Complaint Boxes in All Anganwadi Centers and Schools for Enhanced Grievance Redressal.
- Conduct a weekly inspection of the complaint box in the presence of PRI members, and take prompt action based on the issues raised.





Establish a coaching center for needy students from Priority Group Households, utilizing the support of local educated youths.





Enhance the vibrancy of the Bal Sabha by organizing co-curricular activities led by the village children, allowing them to explore their talents and overcome stage fear.



Organize a special class in each school every month to assess and monitor the reading and writing skills of elementary-level students.





Establish a book bank for the children of the village to cultivate their interest in reading beyond school textbooks, allowing them to gather more knowledge and broaden their horizons.





Provide two saplings to the parents of each newborn baby, symbolizing growth and a greener future.





Corpanize a special drive to immunize all the left-out children of various age groups in the village, ensuring their health and protection.





passenger vehicle drivers and share their contact numbers with all households, ensuring prompt access to transport facilities when needed specially in case of medical emergency.



Set up Sanitary Pad Vending Machines in schools and ensure the availability of pads throughout the year for students.





Set up distribution boxes for contraceptive items in Anganwadi Centers (AWC) and the Health Center to ensure easy access for those in need.





Identify shops within a 200-meter radius of schools and issue notices prohibiting the sale or display of any harmful substances, Penalties may be imposed on shop owners who violate this rule one month after the notice is served.

Set up a 24x7 active Help Desk


