

# **PRADHAN MANTRI JANJATI ADIVASI NYAYA MAHA ABHIYAN (PM-JANMAN)**

# Introduction

- ❑ The Hon'ble Prime Minister has launched the '**Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM- JANMAN)**' at Khunti District, Jharkhand coinciding with the 'Janjatiya Gaurav Divas' on 15th November, 2023.
- ❑ This Mission aims at the targeted development of 75 Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) residing in 18 States and the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- ❑ This Mission is focused on 11 critical interventions through 9 Ministries. The Government of India has recognized the 'REANGs' as the only PVTG in the State.

## Housing benefit to the PVTG- REANG

**Unit Cost:** The provision of pucca houses with a unit cost of Rs. 2.00 lakh per house.

Additional assistance:

- 95 mandays through MGNREGS.
- Toilet facility through SBM.
- Electricity connection.
- Tap water connection.
- Gas connection.

## Exclusion criteria

The parameters for automatic exclusion given in Annexure-I of the FFI of the PMAY-G are relaxed for the 'REANG' PVTG under PM JANMAN and only the following two exclusion criteria are applicable for their identification for providing housing benefits through PMAY- G : -

**a. Household with pucca houses; and**

**b. Household with any member as a Government employee.**

**Note:** Criteria's of PMAY-G such as paying income tax, owning KCC, 5 acres or more irrigated land, any member of the family earning Rs.10,000/- per month etc. has not been included in the PM JANMAN exclusion list.

## Workflow of PMJANMAN (PMAY-G)

- ❑ All the Districts have utilized their manpower at the Blocks and the GP/VCs to carry-out a detailed survey using the modified Awaas+ App (as per the revised exclusion criteria for the PVTGs) for identifying each and every eligible 'REANG' household living in the rural areas of the State for providing housing benefit through PMAY-G.
- ❑ The beneficiary registration exercise was carried out at the time of the survey by modified Awaas+ App.
- ❑ Further, the Aadhar number and the MGNREGA job-card number were captured along with other details.
- ❑ An orientation meeting for this survey and registration process was held on 14th December 2023 and the User Manual (SoP) has already been shared with the Districts and the Blocks. Remaining workflow of PM JANMAN on AwaasSoft will be same as PMAY-G.
- ❑ Priority list has been finalised by the Gram Sabha.
- ❑ Accordingly, registration were done from the block level.
- ❑ Sanction was done at the District level after that instalment has been realising from the block level.



# Timeline of Activities already taken up

16<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup>  
Dec'23

- Identification of the left-out PVTG HHs from the list of habitations
- Awareness activities for the PVTG beneficiaries and the local public representatives about the survey and PM JANMAN program.
- Training of the surveyors at the Block level
- Deployment of teams for door to door survey and registration of the beneficiaries

18<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup>  
Dec'23

- Door to door survey and simultaneous registration of the beneficiaries in the identified villages with 'REANG' population.
- Verification of the list of PVTG beneficiaries identified during the survey by 'Gram Sabha'.
- Publication of the gram sabha verified list of beneficiaries and inviting claims and objections.
- Hearing on the claims and objections by the District Level Appellate Committee members.
- Display of the final priority list.
- Completion of the registration process.

1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>  
Jan'24

- Sanctioning of PMAY-G houses to all the eligible 'REANG' beneficiaries.

10<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>  
Jan'24

- Program of the HPM and interaction with a few 'REANG' beneficiaries to whom houses have been sanctioned under PM JANMAN.

## Aspects covered:

- Beneficiary was assisted by Block Administration to build his own Pucca House.
- Beneficiary is now very happy with his new house.
- The new house brought immense pleasure and safety from natural calamities to the family.
- A PM-JANMAN house was sanctioned by BDO, Bokafa RD Block during FY 2023-24 in favor of Shri. Sumendra Reang as per PVTG eligibility list and Rs.2,00,000/- was transferred to beneficiary's bank account in 3 installments.



# Case Study



## **Background**

Smt **Saflai Bati** Reang W/O – Joy Chandra Reang lived in Bidyajoy Para, very remote Village under Lalcherra Village Committee, Manu RD Block Dhalai Tripura. She live with her husband with 2 kids. They are live in kutchra house and associated with seasonal Jhum cultivation. Now the family is identified for housing benefit in the PM-JANMAN scheme under PMAY-G.

## **Progress of the house construction**

As of now the beneficiary got 2 installments out 3, amounting to Rs. @1.5 lakh and constructed almost roof cast level. Other benefit like 95 man-days, toilet, tap water connection, LPG gas connection also been included along with the housing benefit.

## **Impact on Lifestyle**

- 1) With a solid roof and walls, the family will be better protected from the natural calamity, heavy rain fall, leading to fewer instances of illness. The sanitary toilet and clean water access also contributed to better hygiene and overall health.
- 2) The children, are unable to study in a cramped and dark environment, but in the next couple of days they it will be easy for them as space for learning will be more available. This led to better school attendance and performance.
- 3) Living in a pucca house elevated the family's social status within the community.
