

Timeline: 2nd July - 10th July, 2024

As a prior action, States/UTs must login on awards portal and publish the questionnaire so that it is visible for GPs State can login on awards portal through their respective state logins using default password Admin@123. After logging into the application state would be required to change their password mandatorily.

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

Dear Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary/Secretary

It gives me immense pleasure to share that for the National Panchayat Awards 2024, Gram Panchayats (GPs) will be shortlisted on the basis of selected Panchayat Development Index (PDI) indicators and no separate questionnaire will be used for application for awards and assessment of the applications. Data for some of these indicators will be captured online from various dashboard/portal/MIS of Central Ministries and for the remaining indicators, the datawould need to be entered manually by the GPs on the PDI portal (http://pdi.gov.in/). Further, this data would be auto-ported to National Panchayat Awards portal (www.panchayataward.gov.in/) for award selection purposes.

- 2. You may all recall, on 28th June, 2023, this Ministry had released the PDI report that recommended 577 indicators covering 9 LSDGs themes to measure the performance of Gram Panchayats in implementation of the LSDGs. This Ministry had also conducted a National Writeshop for States/UTs during 10th-11th August, 2023 on PDI portalin New Delhi for further orientation of their GPs in a cascading mode. Now, the GPs need to initiate data entry on this portal for which State/UT Panchayati Raj Departments have been requested to facilitate them in this exercise and monitor the data validation process at Block, District and State/UT level.
- Accordingly, the existing procedure for National Panchayat Awards has been modified with approval of the Minister of Panchayat Raj which is at Annexure-I.The guidelines will also be revised accordingly and communicated separately.
- 4. I, therefore, request all the States/UTs that before the opening of awards portal (www.panchayataward.gov.in) for National Panchayat Awards-2024 competition, all States/UTs may complete the process of constitution of Panchayat Performance Assessment Committees at various levels (Block, District, State/UT) by 30th September, 2023 as per the calendar of activities (Annexure-II) and encourage the GPs to enter the data on PDI portal for various indicators.

4	Remarks of Committees in the verification/recommendation report to be maximum of max.100 words only
5	Field verification and recommendation reports must be uploaded in prescribed format and complete in all respect
6	States/UTs where Panchayat at Block or District level is not existing (as in case of NE states), there state/UT will oversee the selection of GPs through same process
7	Once assessment at District, State, National Level is started then previous levels would not be functional for editing

Ministry will verify such cases once these are recommended for National Panchayat Awards. In this regard, the records of discussions of the meeting held on 01.11.2022 may be referred (enclosed).
- 3. Further, it has been found through a random check that some block level committees have changed the marks of GPs without any evidence and justifications/remarks in the field verification format uploaded. It is informed that the change of marks by the committees at Block/District/state/UT level, if done, must be accompanied with sufficient evidences/justifications, else, the original marks secured by the GP will be considered.
- 4. It is therefore requested that the Block Level selection and nomination process may be completed within timeline i.e. 19th December, 2022 and while adhering to the instructions issues above and through National Panchayat Awards guidelines.
