What are NPAs ?

National Panchayat Awards are Multi-level Pyramid Competition Of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) at Block, District, State or UTs and National Level under 9 Localization of Sustainable Development Goals(LSDG)/themes . Panchayats are ranked and incentivized for their performance in achieving LSDGs at the Panchayat level.

Objective of Awards:-

- i. Assess the performance of PRIs in attainment of SDGs through 9 identified themes
- ii. Promote competitive spirit among PRIs
- iii. Catalyze the process of 'Localization of SDGs through PRIs' and sensitizing the PRIs about significance of attaining LSDG by 2030.

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MAIN GOALS OF THEMES

Theme:1 Poverty Free village

- Comprehensive coverage of all eligible beneficiaries under livelihood and social protection schemes including PDS, ICDS etc.
- Economic Development & employment generation through individual / collective enterprise

Theme 2: Healthy Village

- Eliminate stunting and wasting in 0-6 yrs. of child.
- Eliminate anaemia amongst adolescent girls & women.
- Zero maternal deaths, child deaths under 5 years.
- Provision for medical care and health facilities for all.

Theme: 3 Child Friendly village

- 100% enrolment in the school.
- Reduce Drop-out ratio
- Quality Education
- 100% Immunisation of children
- 100% child labour free.
- No Trafficking cases
- Ensure protected environment from all kinds of violence against children.



Main goals of themes

Theme:4 Water Sufficient Village

- Access to potable water facilities to every household.
- Grey water treatment & purification.
- Address groundwater depletion, arsenic contamination, rainwater harvesting & groundwater recharge.

Theme: 5 Clean and Green Village

- 100% ODF villages
- Solid & Liquid Waste management
- Shift from non-renewable to renewable source of energy.
- Enhanced green cover through social forestry use of local nursery.
- Ensuring conservation of biodiversity and sustainability of ecosystems

Theme: 6 Self-Sufficient Infrastructure

- Ensure establishment of quality infrastructure - GP Bhawan, AWC, Schools, Health Centre, CSC, separate toilets with running tap water provision in schools.
- Ensure all weather connectivity roads, solar street lights and community solar tree, ensure pucca house for all.



Main goals of themes

Theme 7: Socially Secured Village

- Improving living standards of the BPL households
- Ensure social protection through pensions to all eligible
- Appropriate infrastructure and facilities for person with disability (Disabled-friendly).

Theme 8: Village with Good Governance

- Coordination and convergence among various institutions/ stakeholders for preparation of GPDP
- Involvement of SHG/ village committees in localization of SDGs
- Promoting better public service delivery by use of technology.

Theme 9: Women Friendly Village

- 100% immunisation of pregnant women
- Reduce crimes against women and girls.
- Improve participation of women in socio-political, economic activities and participation in community-based organisations.
- Equal wages for equal pay to the women.

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-1:-

- Regular conduct of monthly meeting at Panchayat for discussion on issues and schemes
- 100% enrollment of Women from BPL or economically weaker section in SHGs
- Developing nutri gardens at AWCs/Schools .
- Monitoring proper functioning of AWCs through PRI members.
- Conduct of Gram Sangsads, Bal Sabhas , Mahila Sabhas, Gram Sabha to reach out rural populations.
- IEC activities related with Skill Development Schemes, Loan Facilities for youths for self employment etc on public places or in Gram Sabhas
- Identification and listing of interest youths for skill development training or courses.
- Period monitoring on Ration Shops through PRI .
- Celebration of Rojgar Diwas under MGNREGA , Job Card Distribution, Job card verification
- Health Camp for Job Card Holders
- Enrollment of beneficiaries in schemes related with labour welfare like E-Shram , Nirman Shramik Kalyan Prakalpa etc etc

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-2:-

- Ensuring 100% institutional delivery
- Ensuring 100% Pregnant Women benefitted under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana and monitoring on regular distribution nutritious food among pregnant women specially among anemic mothers.
- 100% immunization for children between 0-6 years
- 100% Coverage of Ayushman Bharat Yojana.
- Installation of Sanitary Pad bending machine at Schools (at least at high and Higher Secondary Schools)
- Toilet Facility at schools with running water facility.
- Monitoring of Mid day Meals given at schools
- Regular meeting of VHNC.
- Health Camps may be organized at Gram Sabhas
- Register may be prepared for cataract patients,
- Monitoring the health of vulnerable section of the society specially above 80/85 years persons, persons with serious alignments , Safai Mitras
- Child care cum feeding room at Public institutes

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-3:-

- 100% enrollment of children at AWCs / schools
- Zero drop out
- Bringing back the drop out student in the education system.
- Conduct Bal Sabhas to know their perception, record and address issues raised in the Bal Sabhas
- Organizing camps for Health Check ups for children
- Separate toilet facility for girls .
- Organizing cultural , sports events on important days
- Maintenance/ Up gradation of AWCs / Schools
- Establishment of e-library
- Kitchen Gardens may established
- Reducing the cases of child marriage through Awareness and intervention of PRIs, Child Line etc

Few Questionnaire for Water sufficient Panchayat (Theme-4)

- What percentage of Own Source Revenue (OSR) was spent by the GP for implementing 'Water Sufficient Panchayat' theme related activities?
- What percentage of schools, anganwadis and public institutions in the GP had coverage of water supply?

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-4:-

- 100% tap water connection to each house holds , public institutions
- Construction of individual soak pit , community soak pits
- Construction of rain water harvesting structures
- Construction of Farm ponds (act as irrigation source and ground water recharge structure)
- Make Village water and sanitation committee functional
- Identification of dysfunctional drinking water sources and repair measure to be taken up to address the water scarcity during dry seasons.
- Regular testing the drinking water quality with coordination with DWS dept.
- Regularize the payment of electric bills of SBDTWs through user committees

Few Questionnaire for Clean and Green Panchayat (Theme-5)

- What percentage of Own Source Revenue (OSR) was spent by the GP for implementing 'Clean and Green Panchayat' theme related activities?
- What percentage of villages in GP had arrangement of Liquid Waste Management?
- What percentage of villages in GP had arrangement of Solid Waste Management?
- Out of total GP expenditure, what percentage had been spent on environmental protection, Toilets, Waste management, Clean Energy, Sustainable Agriculture?
- What percentage of total households in the GP were using clean cooking fuel (LPG/Bio gas)?

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-5:-

- ODF plus activities like IHHLs, individual soak pits, retrofitting of single pit toilets to double pit toilets , Plastic waste segregation centre , tricycles for waste transportation.
- Large scale Plantation drive may be adopted in and around the Panchayat area. Sulthanpur Panchayat(3rd Prize in Theme-5,2022-23 assessment year) of Telangana, planted 50,000 saplings to spread greenery in the Panchayat .
- Regular cleanliness drive at market areas may be taken up.
- Waste bin for all house holds for solid waste management .
- Door to door waste collection involving SHGs .
- Installation stand alone solar street lights , roof top solar system at Panchayat Buildings.
- Construction of soak pit and composed pits for SLWMs .
- Promoting organic farming and use of bio fertilizer by involving Agriculture and Horticulture Departments.
- Implementation of GOBARdhan Project by identifying potential cluster.

- What percentage of Own Source Revenue (OSR) was spent by the GP for implementing 'Self- Sufficient Infrastructure in Panchayat' theme related activities?
- What percentage of Primary school in the GP had own building, library, computer, internet, electricity, play ground? (same question asked on theme 3)
- Whether there was a primary health centres (PHC) and Health sub-centres (HSC) in the GP?
- Whether GP had pipeline connection for water supply to all houses?
- Whether GP building had Computer with Internet facility?
- What percentage of expenditure was made by the GP on infrastructure related activities out of total expenditure?

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-6:-

- Installation of Public information board
- All House holds connected with all weather roads
- Solar Street lights
- IT infrastructure like computer , internet connection for Panchayat Office .
- Ensuring furniture at panchayat offices
- Provision for drainage system
- Clean drinking water for each house hold.
- Housing facility for all eligible beneficiaries .
- Installation of CCTV at important locations of GP , free wi-fi facility etc

Approach may be taken by Panchayat under Theme-6:-

- Ensuring enrollment of Women in Self Help Groups
- Identify eligible beneficiaries for various social pension schemes.
- Identify and prepare a list of differently abled person and periodically monitoring about their requirements such as disability card , health check ups, spread awareness about facilities or Government opportunities
- Promoting farming and allied activities like animal husbandry by involving SHGs .
- Identifying youths for skill training under DDUGKY
- IEC activities through flex / banners/pamphlets about important Government Schemes .

- Wall magazine to display the achievement of Panchayat
