- Untouched SDG 13 and 14 – (LSDG Theme 5)
- Less emphasis on Education
- Few questions only relates to SDG 16 – LSDG Theme 8
- No other departmental responsibilities.
- No auto-ported system to map already entered data.

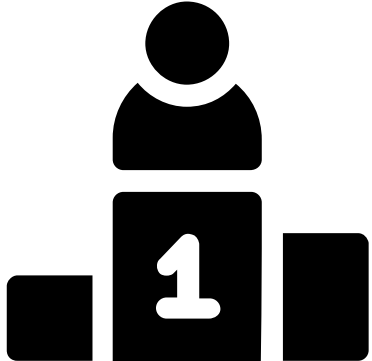
# Ownership of Data
