Approx. 404 SC dominated villages in Tripura

Person committing ATROCITY- NON-SC/ST
 Member

VICTIM- Has to be a Member of SC/ST Community



# APPLICABLE LAW & WHO IS COVERED

- The Prevention of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled
  Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989
- Amended in 2015 and 2018
- Section 2- Definitions covers who is covered under various aspects of law



# **OFFENCES- ATROCITIES**

- forces such member to drink or eat such inedible or obnoxious substance
- dumps excreta, sewage, carcasses or any other obnoxious substance in premises
- dumps excreta, waste matter, carcasses or any other obnoxious substance in his neighbourhood
- garlands with footwear or parades naked or semi-naked



#### interferes with the enjoyment of his rights, including forest rights, over any land or premises or water or irrigation facilities or destroys the crops or takes away the produce

- removing clothes from the person, forcible tonsuring of head, removing moustaches, painting face or body
- wrongfully occupies or cultivates any land, owned by- SC/ST



- forced or bonded labour other than any compulsory service
- compels to dispose or carry human or animal carcasses, or to dig graves
- compels for manual scavenging
- interfering with the right to vote or contest election



# WOMEN CENTERED ATROCITIES

- Devadasi practice/ dedication
- Intentionally touching a woman in sexual manner without her consent
- Sexual harassment
- Causing physical or mental harmwitchcraft
