People's Plan Campaign

Effective strategy for ensuring the preparation of participatory **Panchayat Development Plans** in a campaign mode with voluntary involvement of the community, elected representatives, frontline workers of respective line Departments, SHGs, CBOs and other related stakeholders.

Slogan of PPC- 'Sabki Yojana Sabka Vikas'.

Start from 2nd October on every year.



Objectives of People's Plan Campaign

- Preparation of participatory, comprehensive, and convergent GPDP, BPDP and DPDP in the Gram Panchayats, Intermediate Panchayats and District Panchayats respectively in a time bound manner across the Country.
- Evidence Based Assessment of Progress made during previous years and consideration of proposals for 2024-25 in all 29 subjects of Eleventh Schedule of Constitution and covering 9 themes of Localization of Sustainable Development Goals (LSDGs) at the Panchayats.
- Strengthening the role of ERs.
- Voluntary involvement of SHGs, CBOs etc.
- Evidence-based Assessment of progress based on the gaps identified through PDI data.
- **Inclusion of Themes of LSDGs** as Sankalp for holistic development

Objectives of People's Plan Campaign contd...

- Organize Structured Gram Sabha meetings with active participation and presentations by Frontline Workers of all related Line Departments.
- Organize Bal and Mahila Sabha.
- Effective integration of **Village Prosperity Resilience Plans (VPRPs)** prepared by SHG federations into GPDP.
- Promoting Gender Responsive Governance in the rural areas through effective involvement of Elected Women Representatives (EWRs), Self-Help Groups (SHGs) and women members in the community in the planning process.
- Undertake Public Information Campaign with public disclosure on Schemes, Finances, etc. of all schemes & programmes in Gram Panchayat Office and on Public Information Board.



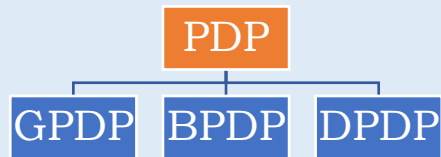
Background of People's Plan Campaign

Activities to be performed during People's Plan Campaign

- Conduct **Special Gram Sabha** on **2nd October**.
- Appointment of **Nodal Officer** at different levels.
- Appointment of **Facilitator** at different levels.
- Appointment of **Frontline Workers** for all Tiers.
- Identification of **SANKALP** under LSDG Themes.
- Scheduling of Gram Sabha/Block Sabha/District Sabha.
- Conduct Gram Sangsad.
- Conduct one Special Gram Sabha/Block Sabha/District Sabha and another Gram Sabha/Block Sabha/District Sabha for plan approval.
- Submission of **Facilitator Feedback**.



Activities to be performed during People's Plan Campaign

- Up-dation of Gram Panchayat Profile in eGramSwaraj portal.
- Mandatory validation of Gram Panchayat Profile at Block Level before GPDP uploading.
- Orientation at State/ District/ Block level PPC/GPDP team.
- GP to allocate minimum 25% resources on the themes on which GP has taken Sankalp, same as earlier.
- At least 25% of the activities of the Sankalp theme are to be chosen from a list of activities.
- Inclusion of Own Source of Revenue in resource envelop
- Activities under 24 major flagship schemes to be included in GPDP
- Scrutiny of some percentage of GPDP at Block, District level and State Level.
- DP and BP may plan some integrated projects benefitting group of GPs
- Indicative projects suggested with scope of convergence covering focus areas:
 - Agri-allied and agro-processing units,
 - Strengthening of supply chain management,
 - Development of cold chain for perishable products,
 - Promotion of livelihood opportunities,
 - Rural industry cluster, etc.



Activities to be performed during People's Plan Campaign contd...

- Display of **Public Information Board**.
- Preparation of **Plan** (GPDP/BPDP/DPDP).
- Plan approval in Gram Sabha/Block Sabha/District Sabha.
- Plan uploading on Web Portal.



Role of Facilitator

- Coordinate with the frontline staff of participating Departments.
- Facilitate the Gram Sabha
- Facilitate Gram Sangsad
- Facilitate Child and Mahila Sabha
- Ensure community mobilization including vulnerable sections like SC/ST/Women/ Minorities/Disabled during the Gram Sabha.
- Submit Facilitator Feedback
- Display of Public Information Board.
- Scheduling of GS and upload on Web Portal.
- Geo tagging of Gram Sabha images.
- Preparation of Plan.
- Uploading of Plan.

Role of Frontline Worker

- Present in Gram Sabha.
- Provide status of departmental schemes and present during Special Gram Sabha.



Problems faced during PPC- Past Experience

- Lack of presence of Line Department.
- Lack of integration of VPRP into GPDP.
- Delay in submission of Facilitator Feedback.
- Delay in scheduling Gram Sabha on Web Portal.
- Delay in uploading geo tagged photo of PIB.
- Lack of participation in Gram Sabha.
- Lack of Realistic Plan.


