The state has been honored with a total of seven prestigious national awards this year, a moment of immense pride for the people of Tripura. The awards are presented by the President of India on **December 11 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi.**

The list of national-level award recipients from Tripura includes:

Best District in the Country: Gomati District – award money ₹5 crore.

Second Best Block in the Country: Amarpur RD Block – award money ₹1.75 crore.

Best Women-Friendly Panchayat in the Country: Dakshin Manubankul, Rupaichhari RD Block – award money ₹1 crore.

Special Award for Second Best Energy-Efficient Panchayat: Thakurchhara, Amarpur RD Block – award money ₹0.75 crore.

Third Prizes for Special Categories:

Poverty-Free and Enhanced Livelihood Village: **Betcherra**, **Kumarghat RD Block**, Adequate Water Supply Village: **Debbari**, **Amarpur RD Block**, Child-Friendly Village: Rankang, **Amarpur RD Block** - **each awarded** ₹0.50 **crore**.

In total, the state has secured total award money amounting to ₹10 crore.
